Also, please take the following questions into consideration when planning your event:

- **Does the event support the vision, mission, and image of Warriors and Quiet Waters?**
  - OUR VISION An America in which a new generation of traumatically injured combat veterans successfully reintegrates into society
  - OUR MISSION To help reintegrate traumatically combat-injured U.S. veterans and active service members from recent wars into society by building hope and resilience, facilitating camaraderie, and providing security and serenity through fly fishing and other high quality therapeutic recreational mediums in southwest Montana

  - Cash contributions?
  - Raising awareness of the programming offered by WQW?
