Also, please take the following questions into consideration when planning your event:

- **Does the event support the vision, mission, and image of Warriors and Quiet Waters?**
 - OUR VISION An America in which a new generation of traumatically injured combat veterans successfully reintegrates into society
 - OUR MISSION Through the experience of fly fishing in Montana, WQW is a catalyst for positive change in the lives of post-9/11 combat veterans.
- **What is your goal for this event?**
 - Cash contributions?
 - Raising awareness of the programming offered by WQW?

What Warriors and Quiet Waters may do for you to support your event:

- Acknowledge direct contributions to WQW and provide appropriate charitable tax deduction information if applicable
- Provide WQW logo for your promotion of the event
- Provide promotion of event through WQW social media sites and/or email marketing
